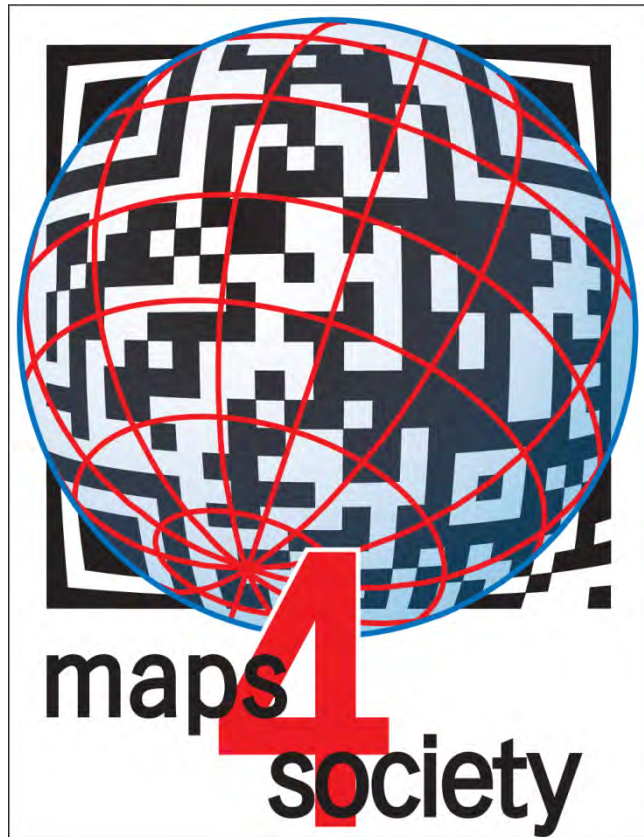




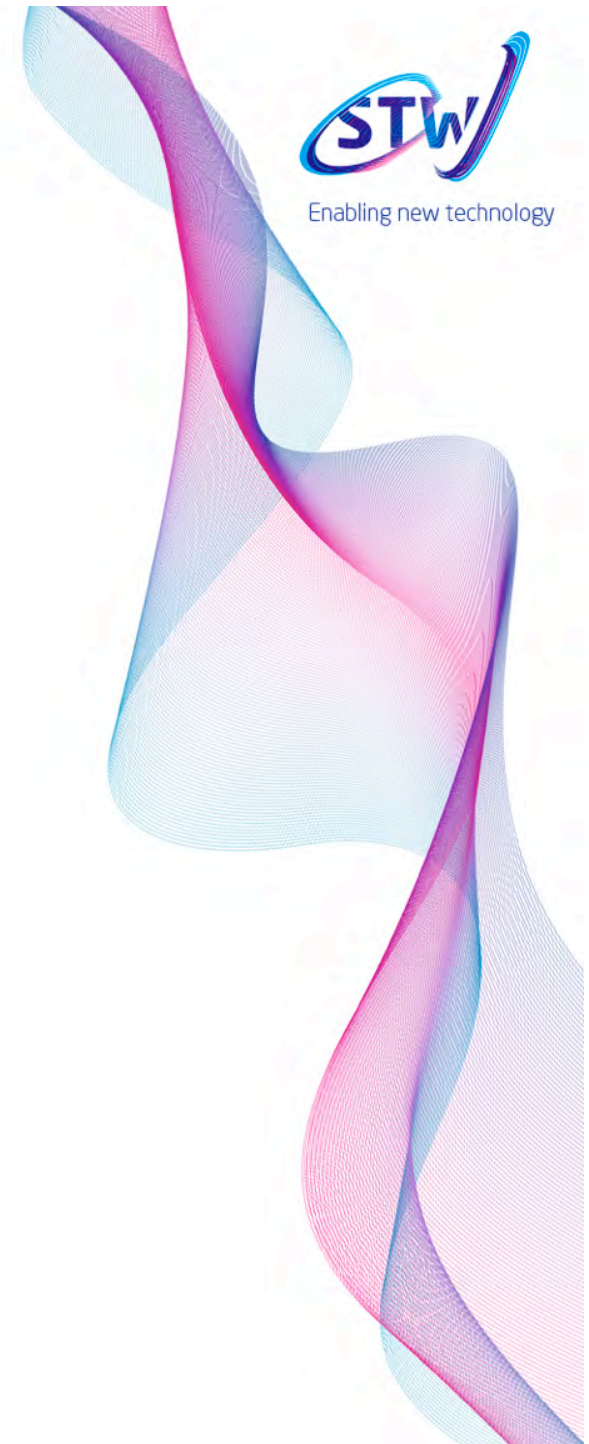

- Targeting products, e.g. for spin-off of research which has already been done



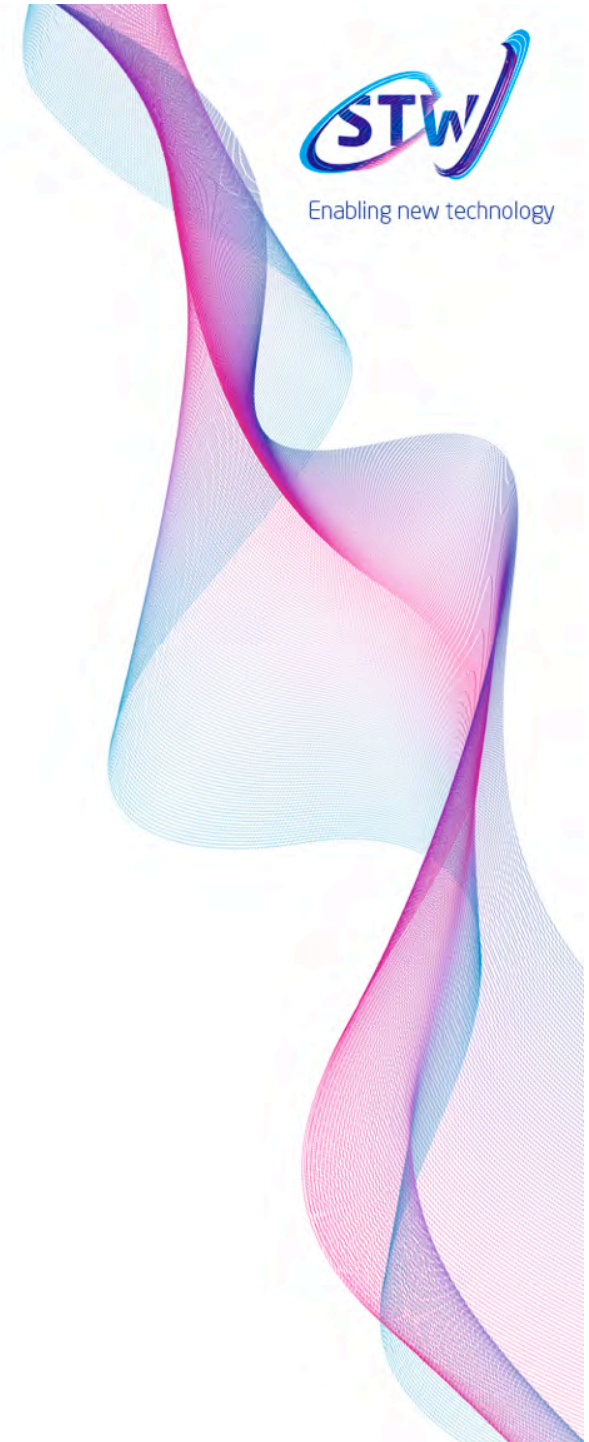
